Release 3.0 – Current GA

Features

- Replaced .NET 6 with .NET 8
- Add a self initiated migration option (where the user can start the migration within a window)
- Remove the use of provisioning packages, using parameters in the runbook instead
- Add option to prevent running a runbook on servers
- Add support to run a command package at start and the end
- Add migration of file and print shares (deferred to 3.1)
- Add migration of local rights
- Add support for AppX applications, including the new Outlook and Teams clients
- Add support for computers with names longer than 15 characters
- Improved the UI of the Runbook screens to be much more intuitive and extensible
- Add support for Offline Domain Join
- Ensure the agent only removes files that OneDrive says have been dehydrated
- Minor fixes to the agent to make it more robust to environmental issues
- Handle migration of Scheduled Tasks, Services
- Handle migration of SQL Server, IIS, COM/DCOM permissions (deferred to 3.1)

Bug fixes

- Ensure PSP MA talks to PSP to confirm the runbooks before starting a runbook (in case of last minute reschedule or cancellation)
- Only remove dehydrated files from OneDrive Sync Client

Release 2.3

Features

- Make all the UI dialogs more prominent

Release 2.2

Features

- Add support for logon names over 50 characters long
- Add reset for Windows Hello for Business
- Add support for Controlled Validation of Cloud Domain Join
- Change all runbooks to SYSTEM

Release 2.1

Features

- Deal with OneNote for post migration
- Report agent version back to the central console
- Upgrade to .Net 6

Bugs fixed

- Hybrid joined devices report as Azure AD if no network access when the agent runs
- use of reg.exe blocked by End Point Protection software

Release 2.0

Features

- Allow multiple selection of source directory in runbook
- Put the uninstall agent step at the bottom of the list
- Obfuscate the agent code
- Optimize agent chat to the central service

Bugs fixed

- Show Migration Complete message after reboot
- Agent removed when the AD/AAD object is removed
