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Purpose of this document

This document describes how to install the PowerSyncPro Service. There are additional documents that you should refer to. These are the Prerequisites document and the Configuration guide which can be obtained from the following locations:

Service Accounts

- 2. Traditional Service Account from Active Directory
- 3. Traditional Service Account from the local server
- 4. Network Service

SQL Recovery Model

Consider setting the recovery model to Simple, unless you are backing up the database and want an ability to roll forward the log files

SQL Memory

As SQL Server loves to take all the memory it is worth considering setting the maximum allowed to be consumed to half of the installed memory, leaving enough for the PowerSyncPro application

Firewall Configuration

The firewall configuration will depend on the strategy for the publishing the PowerSyncPro endpoint the migration agent will connect to. Our preferred option is to have some kind of reverse proxy, Application Gateway, Load Balancer or similar in front of the PowerSyncPro Server. That way the PowerSyncPro



server can have a port opened from that appliance to the PowerSyncPro server, and it is the appliance that is published to the Internet for all Migration Agents to connect to.

If the default TCP ports 5000/5002 are used then the PowerSyncPro Server must have an Inbound rule for TCP Port 5000-5001 ALLOW for all to ensure that Windows Workstations can connect to pull down Runbooks and upload status activity, and that the PSP remote agents can connect.

Hardening Recommendations

In production environments we recommend usual hardening to keep the service as secure as possible, this includes:

- 1. Disable SSL, TLS 1.0 and TLS 1.1 on the PSP Server <u>https://learn.microsoft.com/en-us/windows-server/identity/ad-fs/operations/manage-ssl-protocols-in-ad-fs</u>
- 2. Disable less secure ciphers on the PSP Server <u>http://www.waynezim.com/2011/03/how-to-disable-weak-ssl-protocols-and-ciphers-in-iis/</u>
- 3. Use https throughout, this could be via Application Gateway, IIS Reverse Proxy, Firewall restrictions, etc. If using IIS then consider enabling HSTS to ensure https is used and reduce the possibility of MITM attacks
- Consider limiting the hostnames that are allowed, be that via reverse proxy settings, or directly by adding AllowedHosts to appsettings.json <u>https://learn.microsoft.com/en-</u> <u>us/aspnet/core/fundamentals/servers/kestrel/host-filtering?view=aspnetcore-8.0</u>
- 5. Consider using HSTS to further guard against MITM attacks. <u>https://learn.microsoft.com/en-us/iis/get-started/whats-new-in-iis-10-version-1709/iis-10-version-1709-hsts</u>





PowerSyncPro Service

Install PowerSyncPro Service

On the server that will be hosting the PowerSyncPro service:

- Choose and create a download directory for your source files e.g. C:\SOURCE
- Download or copy the PowerSyncPro MSI to C:\SOURCE
- Double click the PowerSyncProInstaller.msi

The installer will:

- Create the SQL database (if it doesn't exist)
- Add the service account given SQL logon rights, and specified as DB Owner
- Create the folder "PowerSyncPro" under "Program Files"
- Create a folder at C:\ProgramData\Declaration Software\PowerSyncPro
- Create the folder C:\PowerSyncProLogs
 - o This directory will contain additional PowerSyncPro logs for troubleshooting
- Create PowerSyncPro service

Configure Remote Agents

Choose whether you will Enable Remote Agents and if you will use a Self-Signed Certificate or an existing one. Choose your TCP Port number that Remote Agents should connect on. The default port is TCP Port 5001. We recommend keeping this value unless you have an unresolvable port conflict on TCP Port 5001.

Choose Ports (PSP Service)

Choose Service Ports. By default, PowerSyncPro uses TCP Port 5000 for the service. We recommend keeping this value unless you have an unresolvable port conflict on TCP Port 5000.

NOTE: The installer picks the next available port after 4999, so there is potential for the port to be a number higher than 5000 due to prior software installations.

If PowerSyncPro Migration Agent will be used, then Select "Listen on all interfaces" and click "Next"

Reverse Proxy

Please refer to the prerequisites document to ensure that IIS, URL Rewrite and Application Request Routing are installed and configured ready for the reverse proxy configuration.

Using an IIS reverse proxy allows you to have a friendly endpoint name bound to an SSL certificate using TCP port 443 that will not be required when installing Migration Agents. The IIS Reverse Proxy will redirect traffic to the Kestrel back-end.

If you wish to configure a Reverse Proxy, you **must** tick the box.

Note that a configuration here will overwrite any existing web.config (usually in C:\inetpub\wwwroot)

- IIS Website: You can accept the default unless you have specific reason not to
- **Domain to Rewrite to:** This is the friendly endpoint FQDN name your remote agents will connect to. You should have a DNS record for this to the PSP Server. This does not need to be prefixed with http(s)
- **SSL Certificate:** If you have an existing certificate, you can choose it here, or elect to create a new self-signed certificate. We recommend 3rd party trusted SSL certificate if you will be using PowerSyncPro Migration Agent on Windows Workstations that will be connecting on from the internet. Any SSL Cert you choose here should be configured in your IIS Bindings.
